June 18, 2011: Saturday Tour Programme

1. 9:00 - MORNING TOUR: A Guided Tour of Lisbon, the "Soul of Portugal" (3 Hours)



We will visit the beautiful city of Lisbon and discover the Jerónimos (St. Jerome's) Monastery, the Tower of Bélem, the Monument to Henrique the Navigator and the "Discoveries."

We will also see the Praça do Comércio, the old Alfama Quarter, Baixa (the downtown area), Rossio Square, Restauradores, Avenida da Liberdade and Marquês de Pombal Square.

2. 12:30 – BUS TRANSFER TO SINTRA and LUNCH IN THAT REGION

3. 14:00 - AFTERNOON TOUR: A Guided Tour of Sintra's panoramic views and the Estoril Coast (4 Hours)



This will be an unforgettable tour through the luxuriant and eternally green mountains of Sintra (a world heritage site), where we will also pass by Queluz where we will visit the beautiful baroque national palace and its gardens.

We will spend time in the village of Sintra and see its historical center and its Royal Palace. We will then proceed to Cabo da Roca, the western most point on the European Continent, and see the beaches around Guincho.

We will return along the coast and see Cascais, with its typically Portuguese fishing harbor set in a little bay, and Estoril with its casino and gardens.
